

St. John Vianney CYO - Coaching Application Process

Beginning with the 2010 – 2011 school year, the process for applying for a coaching position at St. John Vianney Regional School has been restructured and modified.

The application process, as documented below, will allow for the selection of the most qualified coaches for the CYO Programs provided here at St. John Vianney Regional School.

Notification of Coaching Position

A notification announcing the application period for all head and assistant coaches for the upcoming season will be included in:

- The (3) parish bulletins: Cathedral, St. Pauls, and St. Francis of Assisi
- The St. John Vianney School PIE
- The Cathedral (/ St. John Vianney) CYO Website

Coaching Applications should be printed from our website. The application is under the 'Forms' section of the 'CYO' link.

All individuals interested in applying for a coaching position should complete the application and submit it to the CYO Athletic Director prior to the application deadline.

Head Coach Selections

Once the application period is closed, all applications will be reviewed by the CYO Board.

Phone interviews and / or personal interviews may be held.

The CYO Board will make the final decision for selecting the head coach for each sport.

The CYO Board will respond to all those that have applied for the coaching position.

Assistant Coach Selections

Once the application period is closed, all applications will be reviewed.

Phone or in-person interviews may be held.

A list of assistant coaches will be created based on the qualified applications received.

The CYO Board will notify you that your name has been submitted to the head coach for consideration.

Assistant Coach Selections (Cont.)

The head coach is responsible to select the assistant coaches for his/her team from the list of qualified assistant coaches.

Pertinent experience on the application will be provided to the head coach by the CYO Board to facilitate the selection process of assistant coaches.

Please note that notification may not occur until after assessments are completed.

Coaching Minimum Requirements

All St. John Vianney Coaches will be required to take the “**Protecting God’s Children**” workshop conducted by the Diocese of Allentown. Information / dates for the workshop can be found on the website.

All St. John Vianney Coaches will be subject to a **Background Check** conducted by the SJV CYO.

All St. John Vianney Coaches will be required to attend the “**CYO Coaches Clinic**” conducted by the Diocese of Allentown. Please note that the Allentown Diocese allows a coach up to one year after their first coaching assignment to attend the Coaches Clinic. To clarify, if the Fall 2010 season is your first coaching position in the Diocese of Allentown, you have until the Fall 2011 season to attend the Coaches Clinic. Information / dates for the clinic can be found on the website.

All St. John Vianney Coaches will be required to attend Mass on a weekly basis.

All St. John Vianney Coaches must acknowledge that they have read and will follow the rules and regulations as stated in the “Team Rules and Regulations”, which is the official addendum to the St. John Vianney CYO Bylaws. They can be found on the CYO website.
