# CATHEDRAL SCHOOL

Please enforce our Cathedral philosophy at home – be respectful, be responsible, and be accountable for your actions! Good manners are expected!

- The traditional Flynn & O'Hara uniform includes the navy blue Cathedral sweater which may be worn all day. Navy tights/leotards can be worn during cold weather. On cold days, students may wear sweatpants under uniforms to school and then remove them as buildings are kept very warm.
- November brings thoughts of snow ~ please use our school website for dismissal updates. This will allow office phone lines to remain open for bus companies, radio stations, etc. Local radio stations – WAEB, WFMZ, MIX 100.7 will broadcast **closings** or **late starts** as early as 6:00 A.M. Usually, if Parkland School District closes, so do we. Cathedral School will be mentioned separately. In the event of **early** dismissal due to weather conditions, **please make sure your children have someone to go with and someplace to go**. Please see that all clothing is marked and children have hooded coats, gloves and hats for the bad weather. (Some of our children come to school not properly dressed for winter weather.)



**CATHEDRAL CARE** will not be open if the school has a late start. There is no Cathedral Care when school is closed for snow. With an **Early Dismissal** for Inclement Weather, Cathedral Care **will close 2 hours after** official school closing.
